6. Officers Reports

Additional Comments to reports previously published

President – Helen thanked all those who had organised WCPF events so far this season; Eddy and Pam Lane for the Kingswood Salver and the Knightshayes Trophy; the DPIC team for DPIC and the Print Competition; John Tilsley for the Judging Seminar and Pedro Landers for the Members Exhibition. She commented on the problems we are all facing coming out of lockdown into a very different world and the struggles faced by many clubs as a result. Her aim is to make the WCPF more open and transparent and also more inclusive, there for every club and every member not just the big clubs.

A series of Open House Zoom Meetings will be introduced later in the year, open to any member of any WCPF club to come along to in order to chat, get advice and ask questions. Helen stressed that although the WCPF had no magic wand, we wanted to know if clubs were facing problems. We would offer any advice or support we could.

Directory - Bill emphasised the need for each club to keep their directory information up to date. Any changes or corrections should be sent to Bill Aven by email directory.wcpf@gmail.com

DPIC - Feedback has been generally positive following the return to a live event at the Corn Exchange. Club members were happy with the new format comprising a combined event pre-judged with the Print Competition. Based on comments received, the DPIC team are looking at ways of encouraging more clubs to enter both competitions. Possible changes include fine-tuning the format of the competitions and rebranding of the combined event. The president thanked the DPIC team for their efforts in ensuring a successful return to a live event.

PAGB Awards - The transfer of this Exec post from Russell McGowan to Ann Owens is nearly complete. Russell drew attention to forthcoming PAGB Award adjudications and the President encouraged club members to take up the challenge as a great way of improving their photography. Peter Fry pointed out the free mentoring scheme available from the PAGB.

Audio-Visual - The WCPF AV Competition is the next event on our calendar and will take place at Woodbury Village Hall on Saturday, 29 April 2023.

There is a PAGB AV APM (Awards for Photographic Merit) day currently being planned for August or September 2023. It will be hosted by the WCPF and take place via Zoom. Information will be released soon by the PAGB.

Members Exhibition - Pedro Landers stated that exhibition entries are coming in thick and fast, and quality is high, although the number of entries is currently down a bit when compared with last year. Entries closed on the 11 March.

Selection will be on the weekend of 25/26 March and the exhibition will open with the presentations day on 30 April 2023 and will run for two weeks.

Pedro expressed his thanks to the team of Assistant Exhibition Secretaries (AESs), who provide invaluable assistance by encouraging and collecting entries for the Print Exhibition

Travelling Exhibition - Sue presented the current list of dates for the 2023-24 Travelling Exhibition (see later)

Knightshayes Trophy & Kingswood Salver - The entry for the 2023 Knightshayes Trophy comprised 96 prints. The President presented her chosen subject for the 2024 competition as "Water (in all it's natural states)".

PAGB Representative and PAGB Competitions - Insurance is a hot topic and pricing brackets will be adjusted next year following feedback from clubs nationally. These changes should make the offering of the PAGB's preferred supplier more attractive

Peter runs the PAGB's recorded lecture service and put out a request for new lectures to be offered by photographers in the Federation.

Publicity - No report

Helen repeated the request for a new Publicity Officer. Dennis Knowles kindly offered to photograph WCPF events, but is unable to take on other Publicity duties

Action: Actively pursue the recruitment of a replacement Publicity Officer to undertake the other aspects of the role

Website - Helen repeated Nick's call for sets of images for the Home Page of the website. Each month and different club's images will be featured.

1 President

I will keep this brief as I haven't been in the post long!

The new season has started well with an excellent Kingswood Salver Competition held at Bovey Tracey and judged by Adrian and Jane Lines who gave us a most entertaining talk afterwards. Thank you to Eddy and Pam Lane for organising this ever which ran as smoothly as ever.

I had the pleasure of attending John Tilsley's Judging Workshop in Bristol on 19th November. John was assisted by Sue O'Connell, Ralph Snook, Sandie Cox, Bill Aven, Ken Holland and others. This was an extremely useful day, whether you planned to go onto the assessment stage or not. We all learnt how to better understand and enjoy photography. Seven of those attending have now added their names to the Judging Register which is brilliant – but we still need more. John is organising another workshop in April.

This was followed by DPIC and the Inter-Club Print Competitions in Exeter on 5th February. We tried out a new way of organising these competitions and had them pre-judged in advance and both competitions then run on the same day. The audience on the day saw slideshows incorporating scoring from Ralph with Di Tilsley reading out the titles 'live'. We listened to your comments at the AGM and put two prints from each club up on display followed by the top two clubs and the awarded prints once the results had been announced. We also tried out a new way of holding the raffle and had a longer lunchbreak which allowed more time to chat, eat – and in some cases do street photography in Exeter! I received a lot of feedback after the event, most of it positive, and we have had a number of very good suggestions as to how we can improve next year. Thanks to our DPIC team: Ralph Snook, Russell McGowan, Bill Aven & Stephen Jones; to our Raffle team: Lorraine Robins, Chris Robins and Jo; and to our helpers on the day – the Exec, Di Tilsley, John Tilsley and Morag Landers. The Corn Exchange staff were brilliant and Fotospeed were there all day to offer advice and sales.

The Council Meeting will be held on the same day as the Knightshayes Trophy – thanks to Eddy and Pam Lane for running this once more. Stephen and I have thoroughly enjoyed judging your prints – there were some wonderful entries, and it really was very hard to pick the top three and then our favourites for HCs. The judging is going to be followed by a presentation by Fotospeed and I would like to express my thanks to Fotospeed for their continued support of all our events. The individual awards from the DPIC and the Print Competition will also be presented.

We now look forward to the Members Exhibition, organised by Pedro Landers. Selection will be over the weekend of 25th and 26th March, then the opening and presentation will be at Bovey Tracey Golf Centre on 30th April. The exhibition will run until 14th May. Please note the change of dates to avoid the opening day clashing with the Coronation. The PAGB Inter Federation Competition will be prints only this year and Peter Fry will be selecting our entry from those prints entered the Member's Exhibition – even more incentive for you to get printing!

We also have the WCPF AV competition to enjoy. This will now be held at Woodbury Village Hall on Saturday 29th April (please note the change of date), organised once again by Ian Bateman. Spectators will be most welcome and this is always a great day.

This was a live event and the closing date for prints being entered for the Kingswood Salver Club Competition. The afternoon Talk was given by Robert Harvey ARPS EFIAP CEnv CSci MCIWEM and was based upon his latest impressive book "Britain's Best Landscapes and How to Photograph Them" Web Site <https://www.naturalworldphotography.net>, thoroughly enjoyed by the audience.

2022 Kingswood Salver - Saturday 12th November 2022, Bovey Tracey Golf Club

The Joint Judges and afternoon Speakers were the excellent Jane Lines MPAGB BPE5 and Adrian Lines MPAGB FBPE EFIAP. A LIVE event with all entries submitted as PRINTS at or before the AGM on Saturday 8th October 2022. Online entry for the DPIs of the five prints, plus a sixth DPI of the entire panel, was available from early September 2022.

This was an excellent LIVE event with 20 panels and an audience of over 70. The Lines reviewed all the panels and gave some helpful comments. The winning panel was 'Men with Beards' by Bristol Photographic Society and the winning image for the Vivien Croucher Plate was 'Sadhu' by Mike Hall from the winning panel.

Their afternoon talk was the highly entertaining 'Creative Differences – The lost Years' in which they compared the different styles that they have developed

2023 Knightshayes Trophy - Saturday 11th March 2023 Bovey Tracey

The publicity link on the website. We are still after a publicity officer, however this area could also be used to publish anything that your club may have arranged like exhibitions that the clubs may have organised, where you would like to notify the members of the WCPF of anything regarding your club.
